New Chitose Airport (CTS) / International Cargo Flight Support System

Hokkaido Airports (HAP) provides support of landing fees for international cargo flights that land at New Chitose Airport. The outline of the system is as follows.

- ◆ Applicable Flights : International cargo flight which lands at New Chitose Airport for the purpose of freight transportation (flight with no revenue passengers)
- ◆ Outline : Based on the following calculation table, HAP will support the monthly amount calculated by the number of flights in a month and the weight increase (tonnage) from the previous month.

<Calculation table>

Number of flights in a month	Number of flights support unit price (per flight)	Weight increase support unit price (per ton)
1 to 5	JPY 30,000.-	JPY 2,000.- (Up to JPY 300,000.-)
6 to 10	JPY 45,000.-	
11 to 15	JPY 55,000.-	
16 or more	JPY 70,000.-	

(* Cf. Simulation of amount of support)

12 flights in December and 98 tons increase from the previous month

Category	Number of flights	Weight increase	total amount
Support amount	JPY 485,000.-	JPY 196,000.-	JPY 681,000.-

*Calculation detail: Flight number incentive: JPY485,000

*Breakdown 1 to 5 : 5 x JPY30,000 = JPY150,000

6 to 10 : 5 x JPY45,000 = JPY225,000

11 to 12 : 2 x JPY55,000 = JPY110,000

Weight increase: 98 tons x JPY2,000 = JPY196,000

- ◆ Period : Flights landing from December 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021
- ◆ Budget: JPY 10 million in total *regardless of the period, it will end as soon as the upper limit is reached.
- ◆ Note: Written agreement with HAP will be required to apply the support.
